



Notable MTCA Events to Date









1992

- Underground storage tanks decommissioned
- 1,800 cubic yards of contaminated soil removed

2007

- Testing found light non-aqueous phase liquid (LNAPL or petroleum products that float on top of groundwater)
- Approx. 1,500 gallons of contaminated groundwater were removed by vacuum truck

2008

 Soil vapor investigation found soil vapor levels were below MTCA levels of concern



2009

 Approx. 560 gallons of contaminated groundwater were removed


2013-2014

 Routine groundwater monitoring found that contaminated groundwater beneath the Site remains above MTCA cleanup levels

Agreed Order: 2020




Estimated Timeline

- 2020: Respond to comments, finalize documents, and begin Remedial Investigation/Feasibility Study (RI/FS)
- **2020 & beyond** \rightarrow Public review and comment on RI/FS


