Fishing Vessel Owners Marine Ways Inc. has applied for a National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit modification in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 90.48 Revised Code of Washington, Chapter 173-220 Washington Administrative Code, and the Federal Clean Water Act. The proposed modification is to change the monitoring protocol for marine way launches from quarterly to visual for all launches and eliminate one stormwater monitoring location. A final determination will not be made until all timely comments received in response to this notice have been evaluated.
