RE: Minor Revision of NPDES Permit No. WA0023183 for the City of Cashmere POTW

Dear Steve Crocci:

Thank you for bringing to our attention the typographical error contained in Footnote "k" of S2.A. Monitoring schedule table. This revision includes the following:

- *Change Footnote (k), the kilograms per day (kg/day) equation, to no longer be divided by 1,000 (page 13).*

The permit requires the Cashmere POTW to report the water quality-based effluent limit for phosphorus expressed as kg/day.

A division by 1,000 in the equation would result in an improper reported value expressed in grams per day. Removing the division by 1,000 ensures the reported values to be properly calculated and reported as required by permit in kg/day.

Enclosed is a replacement permit for your National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) Permit No. WA0023183. The changes do not affect the stringency of the permit and therefore does not require public notice. Please have your staff replace the original permit with the enclosed revised permit. The page is clearly marked at the bottom "**THIS PAGE REVISED ON JULY 14, 2020**".
