APPLICANT: Public Utility District No. 1 of Chelan County

Public Utility District No. 1 of Chelan County has applied for new National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) Permits in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 90.48 Revised Code of Washington (RCW), Chapter 173-220 Washington Administrative Code (WAC), and the Federal Clean Water Act.

Rocky Reach Dam, Permit No. WA0991033, Hwy 97, 6 miles north of Wenatchee, WA - Following evaluation of the application and other available information, a draft permit will be developed which would allow the discharge of industrial wastewater (non-contact cooling water/sumps) to the Columbia River. Rock Island Dam, Permit No. WA0991032, Hwy 28, 12 miles south of Wenatchee, WA - Following evaluation of the application and other available information, a draft permit will be developed which would allow the discharge of industrial wastewater (non-contact cooling water/sumps) to the Columbia River. A tentative determination has been made to issue a proposed permits based on the effluent limitations and special permit conditions that will prevent and control pollution. A final determination will not be made until all timely comments received in response to this notice have been evaluated.

Any interested party may request a public hearing on the proposed permit within 30 days of the publication date of this notice. The request for a hearing shall state the interest of the party and the reasons why a hearing is necessary. The request should be sent to the above address. Ecology will hold a hearing if it determines that there is significant public interest. If a hearing is to be held, public notice will be published at least 30 days in advance of the hearing date. Any party responding to this notice with comments will be mailed a copy of a hearing public notice.
