
Dear Vijay,

As required per Section 11 of Waste Discharge Permit No ST0005370, The ACRL has reviewed the Slug Discharge Control Plan described in our "Leachate Discharge Plan for the Asotin County Landfill (December 2014)".

Slug discharge, described in Section 5.1-3, discusses relatively low flows of wastewater generated from the administrative building and the controls in the leachate pump station for manual switch in case of torrential downpours or an event that would overwhelm the pump stations, specifically quantities over 2,500 gpd. We currently collect daily flow readings for these locations and our gpd are far under the 2,500 gpd threshold (except in rare and unique circumstances). As such, I do not recommend any updates or changes to the current plan as written.
