Dear Kelly Merz:

On September 21, 2022, Ecology received a request via email submitted by Erik Thornburgh with Water and Wastewater Services on behalf of the Permittee, requesting BOD monitoring frequency to be reduced from once every 2 weeks to monthly for the above referenced-permit. The basis for the request is as stated in footnote “d” in S2.A of the permit which allows the permittee to request for a monitoring reduction for BOD from once every 2 weeks to monthly after 20 consecutive samples results indicate the measured concentrations do not exceed the BOD concentration of 40 mg/L. Ecology has verified the data, and is hereby approved the monitoring frequency for BOD to be reduced from once every 2 weeks to monthly effective October 1, 2022. Ecology will update the WQWebDMR for WA State FTA to reflect this change.
