RE: Issuance of Modified State Waste Discharge Permit ST0005398

Dear Lynn Eppich:

Basin City Mobile Home Park's modified State Waste Discharge permit ST0005398 is enclosed. The Department of Ecology (Ecology) issues this permit in accordance with Chapter 90.48 RCW, as amended.

Ecology published a legal notice of draft permit modification on January 22, 2020 in the Tri-City Herald to inform the public that a draft modified permit was available for review.

Because of significant changes in process due to COVID-19 and an error on Ecology's part, the final issuance of the enclosed permit modification was delayed. Ecology apologizes for the delay and has dated the effective date of the modified permit back to June 1, 2020, the original date that the document should have been issued based on the permit process Ecology has in place.

Permit Fees

In response to the passage of Initiative 97 in 1988, Ecology has adopted a regulation to recover costs associated with issuing and administering wastewater discharge permits (Chapter 173-224 WAC).

Ecology calculates the annual fee for both industrial and municipal/domestic discharges according to the permit fee schedules contained in WAC 173-224-040. We notify permit holders of fee charges by mailed billing statements. Failure to pay the applicable permit fee may result in the suspension or revocation of the permit and could result in the issuance of civil penalties or actions to enjoin the activity under the permit.

Appeal Process

You have the right to appeal this permit (chapter 43.21B RCW). The Board must RECEIVE your appeal within 30 days of the “receipt” date. Failure to comply with the 30-day filing deadline will result in termination or dismissal of the appeal. **You may only file an appeal on the modified portions of the permit.**

File the original and one copy of the appeal with the Pollution Control Hearings Board by mail or by hand delivery (addresses below). Filing means actual receipt with the PCHB during regular business hours.
