

Addendum to the Fact Sheet for State Waste Discharge Permit ST0501338

Modification Date: December 7, 2023

1. Permit Modification Overview

On October 26, 2023, Ecology received a permit transfer request for State Waste Discharge Permit ST0501338. The facility is transferring ownership from SeaCast Arlington LLC to Blue Origin LLC, effective October 2, 2023. The facility name is also switching from SeaCast Arlington to Blue Origin LLC. This permit modification reflects the change in ownership and responsible party. Relevant changes in the permit are identified by gray highlighting.

Ecology proposes to retain the existing permit expiration date of January 31, 2028. The proposed modification is effective immediately.

Appendix A - Your Right to Appeal

You have a right to appeal this permit to the Pollution Control Hearing Board (PCHB) within 30 days of the date of receipt of the final permit. The appeal process is governed by chapter 43.21B RCW and chapter 371-08 WAC. "Date of receipt" is defined in RCW 43.21B.001(2) (see glossary).

To appeal you must do the following within 30 days of the date of receipt of this permit:

- File your appeal and a copy of this permit with the PCHB (see addresses below). Filing means actual receipt by the PCHB during regular business hours as defined in WAC 371-08-305 and -335. "Notice of appeal" is defined in WAC 371-08-340.
- Serve a copy of your appeal and this permit on Ecology on the Department of Ecology mail, in person, or by email (see addresses below).
- You must also comply with other applicable requirements in chapter 43.21B RCW and chapter 371-08 WAC.
