

**Addendum to the Fact Sheet for
National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System

1. General Information

This is an addendum to the fact sheet addendum to explain changes proposed for NPDES Permit No. WA0001546 (Permit) issued on January 7, 2022. Ecology is correcting the Expiration Date of the Permit to January 31, 2027.

Note: New text in the modified Permit is marked with grey highlight.

2. Modification to the Permit

Page 1, Expiration Date to be changed from January 31, 2026, to January 31, 2027.

3. Justification

It came to Ecology's attention that on the Page 1 of the Permit, the Expiration Date is listed as January 31, 2026, which is four (4) years from the Effective Date of February 1, 2022. On page 6 of the Reauthorization Addendum, it states "Ecology proposes to reissue this permit for five years." Ecology is correcting the typographical error in the Expiration Date.

The proposed changes made in this modification are considered to constitute a minor modification under 40 CFR 122.63 and WAC 173-220-190.

4. Public Process

40 CFR 122.63 states “Upon the consent of the permittee, the Director may modify a permit to make the corrections or allowances for changes in the permitted activity listed in this section, without following the procedures of part 124. Any permit modification not processed as a minor modification under this section must be made for cause and with part 124 draft permit and public notice as required in [§ 122.62](#). Minor modifications may... (a) Correct typographical errors...”

Ecology determined that changing the Expiration Date does **not** lessen the stringency of effluent limits in this permit, and that the change meets the requirements as stated in 40 CFR 122.63 and WAC 173-220-190 to proceed as a **minor** permit modification.

Therefore, the changes made in the above-referenced permit are **not** required to be published for a 30-day public review and comment period.

Permit Appeal Process

Appendix A - Your Right to Appeal

You have a right to appeal this permit to the Pollution Control Hearing Board (PCHB) within 30 days of the date of receipt of the final permit. The appeal process is governed by chapter 43.21B RCW and chapter 371-08 WAC. "Date of receipt" is defined in RCW 43.21B.001(2) (see glossary).

To appeal you must do the following within 30 days of the date of receipt of this permit:

- File your appeal and a copy of this permit with the PCHB (see addresses below). Filing means actual receipt by the PCHB during regular business hours as defined in WAC 371-08-305 and -335. "Notice of appeal" is defined in WAC 371-08-340.
- Serve a copy of your appeal and this permit on Ecology on the Department of Ecology mail, in person, or by email (see addresses below).
- You must also comply with other applicable requirements in Chapter 43.21B RCW and Chapter 371-08 WAC.
