RE: Level One Response 3rd Quarter 2007 (Permit No. SO3-001680D).

Dear Mr. Gilman,

Stormwater sampling was conducted at Trident Seafood Corporation's facility located at 1124 54th Ave East, Fife. Tested parameters included Turbidity, pH, Zinc (total), Nitrate/Nitrite as N, Phosphorus, BOD5, and Oil & Grease.

Analysis results in the 3rd quarter for 2007 for pH revealed a result outside the listed Benchmark Levels in the Industrial Stormwater General Permit (ISGP). The plant is decommissioned. The facility's original industrial activity has ceased and will not be restarted under Trident Seafoods.

The facility is being offered for sale to various potential buyers and the back yard area is clear of machinery

The facility is in caretaker status with one or two employees. The pH level of 5.25 is outside the Benchmark Levels, but without any industrial activity, it is unknown what has contributed to this result.

This letter is to provide notice of exceedance of benchmark levels during the 3rd quarter of 2007.
