**RE: Time to Reapply for the Industrial Stormwater General Permit**

Dear Jim Harberg:

The purpose of this letter is to remind you to reapply for coverage under the Industrial Stormwater General Permit (ISGP), and provide information on the ISGP reissuance process.

State and Federal rules require permit holders to reapply for permit coverage at least 180 days prior to the expiration date of the current ISGP, which expires on January 1, 2015.

- Ecology has created a new online ISGP application that requires applicants to login to SecureAccess Washington (SAW) at <https://secureaccess.wa.gov>
- Instructions are enclosed for your convenience.

- **Please submit your online application by July 5, 2014.**
- In November 2014, Ecology will send you a letter confirming your renewed permit coverage along with a copy of the new ISGP.
- If you fail to reapply for the ISGP, your current permit will be cancelled on January 1, 2015. Discharging stormwater associated with industrial activity without the proper permits may result in enforcement action, including monetary penalties.

Ecology is in the process of updating and reissuing the ISGP. Before the new ISGP is finalized, permit holders and other interested parties have an opportunity to review and submit comments on the draft ISGP from May 7 through June 20, 2014. All public comments received by Ecology will be considered before issuing the final ISGP in November 2014, with an effective date of January 1, 2015.

Ecology will host a series of six public workshops to explain proposed changes to the ISGP and answer questions. The two Seattle workshops will be followed by public hearings that will allow interested parties to provide oral testimony on the draft ISGP.
