The Washington State Department of Ecology (Ecology) received your Notice of Intent for coverage under Ecology's Water Treatment Plant General Permit (permit). This is your permit coverage letter. Your permit coverage is effective on October 10, 2014. **Please retain this permit coverage letter with your permit (enclosed) any other documents required on site (e.g., operation and maintenance manual, solid waste control plan, stormwater pollution prevention plan, spill contingency plan, and monitoring reports).** These materials are part of the official record of permit coverage for your facility.

Please take time to read the entire permit and contact Ecology if you have any questions.

Appeal Process

You or a third-party has a right to appeal coverage under this general permit to the Pollution Control Hearings Board (PCHB) within 30 days of the date of receipt of this letter. This appeal is limited to the general permit's applicability or non-applicability to a specific discharger. The appeal process is governed by Chapter 43.21B Revised Code of Washington (RCW) and Chapter 371-08 Washington Administrative Code (WAC). "Date of receipt" is defined in RCW 43.21B.001(2).

To appeal, you must do the following within 30 days of the date of receipt of this letter:

- File your appeal and a copy of the permit cover page with the PCHB (see addresses below). Filing means actual receipt by the PCHB during regular business hours.
- Serve a copy of your appeal and the permit cover page on Ecology in paper form - by mail or in person (see addresses below). E-mail is not accepted.

You must also comply with other applicable requirements in Chapter 43.21B RCW and Chapter 371-08 WAC.

Electronic Discharge Monitoring Reports (WQWebDMR)



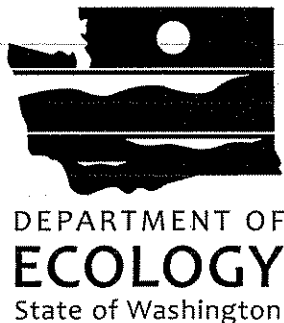
