Thank you for submitting an application for renewal of State Waste Discharge Permit Number ST0501285 for Ancient Lake Wine Company. Ecology accepted the application as complete on September 16, 2014.

Based on the information in your application, your permit manager will begin the next phase of the permitting process and start writing Ancient Lake Wine Company's permit and fact sheet. As she drafts the permit, she may contact you with questions or request a visit to your facility.

Ancient Lake Wine Company's new permit will require online submission of Discharge Monitoring Reports (DMRs) by using WQWebDMR, Ecology's electronic data reporting system. Please register online for a WQWebDMR account. All WQWebDMR users will need to register for their own user ID and password.


Additionally, I am enclosing the Cashiering Receipt for your State Wastewater Discharge Permit Application Fee.

This provides the public a chance to be aware of, and comment on, any wastewater treatment and disposal facilities. The Public Notice will be published by Ecology on December 19, 2014 and December 26, 2014 in the Columbia Basin Herald.
