The last three out of four samples have had elevated Turbidity levels exceeding 50 NTU.

A Compliance Inspection was done on 4/23/08 by WDOE, SWRO and it was found that the current sampling point (SW-1) is not representative of stormwater discharge leaving the site. A Change of Information form has been sent to Josh Klimek, of WDOE, Water Quality Program identifying the more representative sampling point.

The following outlines source controls that will be implemented to reduce the Turbidity levels to at or below benchmark values.

- 4 Reduce Turbidity by installing Drain Filters
- 4 Sweep area on a monthly basis adjusting frequency as needed.

I believe these practices will result in a reduction of our turbidity levels.
