Dear Ms. Berg:

Your February and March 2015 Discharge Monitoring Reports (DMRs) show that your facility was out of compliance with your NPDES permit special condition S1.B, discharge limits of stormwater pH discharges as listed below:

Sample Date	Outfall	Monitoring Parameter	Sample Measurement	Daily Minimum Limit
02/08/2015	001	pH, Standard Units	5.5	6.0
03/31/2015	001	pH, Standard Units	5.3	6.0

The DMR is the principal tool used to evaluate compliance with permit requirements. The Department of Ecology places great importance on timely submittal of complete and accurate DMRs. Failure to comply with the conditions of your permit could result in Ecology taking formal administrative enforcement action, including issuing orders and penalties.
