has filed a SEPA checklist and application for a new of State Waste Discharge Permit No. ST-9265 in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 90.48 Revised Code of Washington (RCW), Chapter 173-216 Washington Administrative Code (WAC), and the Federal Water Pollution Control Act as amended.

Following evaluation of the application and other available information, a draft permit will be developed which would allow the discharge of ore processing wastewater to an existing onsite settling pond from the Mieras Mill ore processing site located at NE1/4 of the NW1/4 of Section 11, Township 20N, Range 17E, Kittitas County. All discharges to be in compliance with the Department of Ecology's Water Quality Standards for a permit to be issued.

The Department of Ecology has determined that it will take no further action on this application at this time. The application and all attachments, submitted January 28, 2008 and accepted January 29, 2008, will become a "temporary permit" effective 30 days following the final date of this notice. Operation consistent with the application and attachments shall be authorized for a period up to 5 years or until Ecology issues a formal permit. A final determination will not be made until all timely comments received in response to this notice have been evaluated.

SEPA DETERMINATION

The Department has issued a Determination of Nonsignificance (DNS) under the State Environmental Policy Act (SEPA) for this project. After review of the completed Environmental Checklist and other information on file with the agency, Ecology has made a determination that this proposal will not have a probable significant adverse impact on the environment.

Any interested party may request a public hearing on the proposed permit within 30 days of the publication date of this notice. The request for a hearing shall state the interest of the party and the reasons why a hearing is necessary. The request should be sent to the above address. The Department will hold a hearing if it determines that there is significant public interest. If a hearing is to be held, public notice will be published at least 30 days in advance of the hearing date. Any party responding to this notice with comments will be mailed a copy of a hearing public notice.
