Dear Permittee:

On July 6, 2016, the Washington State Department of Ecology (Ecology) reissued the Boatyard General Permit (permit). Ecology is issuing your facility coverage under the new permit based on the information you provided in your application. A copy of your new permit is enclosed. The effective date of the new permit is August 8, 2016.

**Coverage Page and Authorization**

Coverage under this general permit is limited to the discharges specified on the enclosed coverage page. **Retain the enclosed coverage page on site, or within easy access from your site. The enclosed coverage page is the official record of permit coverage for your site.** Please review all of the information on your coverage page. Contact Ecology if changes are necessary.

**Electronic Discharge Monitoring Reports**

You must now submit your discharge monitoring reports (DMRs) electronically using Ecology's Water Quality Permitting Portal (WQWebDMR), unless you have applied for and received an electronic reporting waiver. Ecology typically grants electronic reporting waivers only to permittees that do not have a computer or access to the Internet. If you have not already done so, you must obtain a SecureAccess Washington (SAW) account, add service for WQWebDMR, and submit an Electronic Signature Account Form (ESAF). To submit an ESAF, you must print the form, have the person in your organization with legal responsibility sign it, and mail it to the address on the signature page. If you have previously submitted an ESAF, you do not need to submit another one.

**Right to Appeal the Permit**

You have a right to appeal the terms and conditions of the permit as they apply to an individual discharger within 30 days following the effective date of coverage, in accordance with RCW 43.21 B and Chapter 371-08 WAC. This type of appeal is limited to the permit's applicability or non-applicability to a specific discharger.

You must file your appeal in writing to both the Pollution Control Hearings Board (PCHB) and Ecology within 30 days following the effective date of coverage at the addresses provided below. Appeals may not be delivered by email.

#### **Fees**


