Thank you for your interest in the Spokane River Permits. I appreciate your support of Ecology's community based toxics management strategy for achieving water quality criteria in the Spokane River. As Waterkeeper of Lake Coeur d'Alene, the headwaters of the Spokane River, your participation in the Spokane River Regional Toxics Task Force provides opportunity for the group to take a holistic approach to toxics in the watershed.

As we discussed at the Toxics Task Force Meeting on August 10, 2016, Ecology will extend the Public Comment Period by 15 days to September 13, 2016, for Kaiser, City of Spokane, and Liberty Lake NPDES permits. Ecology permit writers will meet with interested stakeholders to discuss development process for the permits. An Ecology permit writer will contact you to arrange for a meeting to discuss the permits by August 26, 2016.
