Dear Ms. Murray:

You applied for Conditional No Exposure (CNE) Certification on July 13, 2009.

A review of our records shows that we have not responded to your CNE application. We apologize for the tardiness of our reply and regret any inconvenience this delay may have caused.

A Washington State Department of Ecology (Ecology) inspector has determined that your site is eligible for CNE Certification. Your application has been granted.

If there is a change at the facility that results in the exposure of industrial activities or materials to stormwater, you are required to immediately apply for and obtain a permit (Industrial Stormwater General Permit Special Condition S1.F.1.d). Ecology may also conduct a site visit in the future to verify that pollutants are not exposed to stormwater at your site.

You are required to reapply for CNE Certification once every five years or by October 1, 2013, whichever is earlier.
