The notice in the exact form annexed, was published in regular issues of the Whitman County Gazette, which was regularly distributed to its subscribers during the below stated period. The annexed





The proposed project, WA DOT US
195/Colfax to Spangle/add PL, is
located on US 195 from MP 45.70 to
MP 47.95 and from MP 48.50 to MP
50.20 in Whitman County near
Stepcoe. The end of the first section
is about 0.8 miles south of Stepcoe
and the second section starts about
0.5 miles north of Stepcoe. This project
involves 30 acres of soil disturbance
for Highway and Road construction
activities. The receiving waterbodies
are multiple Unknown Tributaries to
Dry Creek. Any persons desiring to
precent their views to the
Washington State Department of
Ecology regarding this application, or
interested in Ecology's action on this
application, may notify Ecology in
writing no later than 30 days of the
last date of publication of this notice.
Ecology reviews public comments and
considers whether discharges from this
project would cause a measurable
change in receiving water quality,
and, if so, whether the project is
necessary and in the overriding public
interest according to Tier II anti-
degradation requirements under
WAC 173-201A-020.
