Section D: Comments and Observations

The Meridian Center for Health construction project is covered under Ecology's Construction Stormwater General Permit (CSWGP #WAR303187). On 3/13/2017, Ecology has not yet received a Notice of Termination (NOT) form for this project. The purpose of this inspection was to conduct a construction inspection. While on site the inspector determined this site is eligible for termination of permit coverage once a (NOT) form has been submitted.

Observations:

- Building and grounds are completely finished and being used as a health center with a park setting. There is no active construction, no temporary BMPs, and no bare soils at the site. Site is ready for close out but permittee must submit a (NOT) form.

Section E: Compliance Requirements and Recommendations

This site does not meet the requirements for termination of CSWGP coverage as outlined in permit condition S10.A. In order to be eligible for termination of permit coverage, the Meridian Center for Health project must ensure the proper Notice of Termination (NOT) form has been submitted.

- Submit an NOT to Ecology once all soils onsite are fully stabilized and all temporary BMPs are removed.
- **Until such time as termination of permit coverage is approved, the Meridian Center for Health project is required to comply with all terms and conditions of the CSWGP, including conducting site inspections and discharge monitoring in accordance with permit condition S4.**
