Dear Ms. Westbrook and Mr. Lafer:

The Department of Ecology acknowledges receiving an application for permit renewal for the City of Carnation Wastewater and Reclaimed Water Treatment Plant on December 29, 2017. The applications have been reviewed and accepted as complete on April 18, 2018.

Your current permit has an expiration date of December 31, 2018. Renewal of your permit is in process; however, the permit may not be issued by the expiration date. If your new permit is not issued and effective by the current permit's expiration date, then the current permit and its terms and conditions are administratively extended and will remain in effect and enforceable until Ecology issues a new permit and it becomes effective for your facility, in accordance with the Washington State Administrative Procedures Act (RCW 34.05.422(3)) and Washington Administrative Code 173-220-180(5).

State law requires the circulation and publication of notices which describe the proposed issuance of new or renewed state reclaimed water permits. This is intended to allow the public to be aware of and comment on such actions.


