Dear Troy Anderson:

Thank you for the March 7, 2019 submittal of page 4 of the state waste discharge permit application. This page was submitted to revise the maximum daily wastewater discharge flow in Section C.3.

The purpose of this letter is adjust the permit fee category and application fee for Old Schoolhouse Brewery, Inc.

Ecology has adopted a regulation (Chapter 173-224 WAC) establishing annual permit fees for all municipal/domestic and industrial wastewater discharge permit holders. The regulation also establishes an application fee for first time permit applicants as being either \$250.00 or twenty-five percent of the annual permit fee category assigned the applicant, whichever is greater. After reviewing the information submitted in your application, you have been assessed an application fee of **\$490.25** which reflects the following in the application fee schedule:

Subcategory:	a. <1,000 gpd
Annual Fee:	\$1,961.00

Your permit will be subject to this fee commencing on its effective date of **April 21, 2019**. You will be officially notified of the amount of the fee, payment schedules, and other details by the Ecology Fiscal Office. Please contact Charles Gilman at 360/407-6425 with any fee related questions.

This fee must be paid before the permit needed for your facility to be in compliance with State and Federal laws can be issued. If you do not agree with the application fee assessed for your



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facility, you may file an appeal explaining the basis for your disagreement. Please mail your appeal to:

The Department of Ecology will publish a notice in the "Legal Classified Section" of the **Methow Valley News** on **March 13**, and **March 20, 2019**. There will be a 30 day comment period from the last publication date. Comments received during this period will be considered in the formulation of the temporary permit.

Since the Department is unable to act upon the application during the 60 days following acceptance on March 1, 2019, according to RCW 90.48.200, the application and attachments will provide the basis for a **Temporary Permit**. That permit will **become effective 30 days after the final publication date**, provided:

1. no significant comments are received;
2. the details of monitoring, reporting and interim limits are worked out and appended to the application; and
3. the permit application fee has been paid.

The Temporary Permit will remain valid for up to five years or until a formal permit can be written.
