
Thank you for submitting the Application to Discharge Industrial Wastewater to a Publicly Owned Treatment Works (POTW) and the Application to Discharge Process Wastewater for New Sources for Solvay Chemicals, Inc. (Solvay) received April 8, 2019. The Department of Ecology (Ecology) requested additional information in order to determine completeness for the application package. Ecology received an amendment to the application package electronically on June 28, 2019. The information contained in the amended application package is adequate to begin drafting the National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) Permit. Therefore, Ecology accepts the amended application package as complete.

Solvay is currently permitted under State Waste Discharge (SWD) Permit ST0006070. Solvay will be issued an individual NPDES Permit which will include the SWD requirements. Until an individual NPDES Permit is issued, Solvay will continue to have permit coverage under SWD Permit ST0006070.

During the initial permitting process, Ecology may determine that additional information is necessary to complete the permit. In order to maintain complete application status, Solvay must provide any additional information Ecology may request in a timely manner.
