

Pacific Northern Construction Company, 210 - 27th Avenue S.E., Building A, Suite 300, Puyallup, WA 98374, is seeking coverage under the Washington State Department of Ecology's Construction Stormwater NPDES and State Waste Discharge General Permit. The proposed Legacy Plaza Senior Living facility is located at 36 West Main in Auburn, King County, Washington. The project will disturb approximately 1.5-acres for construction of a multi-story senior living building with single-level underground parking and first floor retail/office use space. Along with building construction the project will also include demolition of existing asphalt, grading, storm drainage facility, water and sanitary sewer extensions, paved parking, landscaping, franchise utilities and roadway improvements. Existing contaminated soils will be excavated per Department of Ecology standards and the excavation pit will be backfilled and TESC measures will be established. Construction stormwater will be routed via v-ditches and rock check dams to a temporary erosion control pond for detention and pumped to a Baker tank for water quality treatment, then discharged to the nearest existing catch basin to the site. Stormwater flows west to enter Mill Creek and then north to ultimately discharge to the Green River. Any person desiring to present their views to the department of Ecology regarding this application may do so in writing within thirty days of the last date of publication of this notice. Comments shall be submitted to the department of Ecology. Any person interested in the department's action on this application may notify the department of their interest within thirty days of the last date of publication of this notice. Ecology reviews public comments and considers whether discharges from the project would cause a measurable change in receiving water quality, and, if so, whether the project is necessary and in the overriding public interest according to Tier II antidegradation requirements under WAC 173-201A-320.
