Please find the end of month biomass, feed and disease control chemical use summary report for the month of August 2019. Copies of this report have also been submitted through the WQWebPortal system at the Department of Ecology as required by the renewed NPDES permits for the Clam Bay, Fort Ward, Orchard Rocks and Hope Island farms. As noted in the report, the fish raised at the Clam Bay farm were harvested out on August 21<sup>st</sup> and the fish containment nets have been removed from the site for cleaning and repair. Even though we will be using the WQWebPortal for all future routine discharge monitoring with regard to the four farms with the new NPDES permits, I will continue to send copies of this report to DOE, DNR and DFW that also includes information for the Port Angeles and Cypress Island farm sites until that situation is resolved.
