

Seattle Department of Transportation Notice of Intent for NPDES Construction Stormwater General Permit

Seattle Department of Transportation, PO Box 34996 MS 3800 Seattle, WA 98124, is seeking coverage under the Washington State Department of Ecology's Construction Stormwater General Permit. The proposed project, the 2020 NW Market St AAC Paving Project, is located along NW Market St from 24th Ave NW to 15th Ave NW in Seattle, WA. This project involves 4.4 acres of soil disturbance for pavement repair and replacement, sidewalk repair and pedestrian crossing improvements, ADA curb ramp upgrades, and stormwater and other utility construction activities. Storm water from the project will discharge to the Lake Washington Ship Canal. **Any persons desiring to present their views to the Washington State Department of Ecology regarding this application, or interested in Ecology's action on this application, may notify Ecology in writing no later than 30 days of the last date of publication of this notice. Ecology reviews public comments and considers whether discharges from this project would cause a measurable change in receiving water quality, and, if so, whether the project is necessary and in the overriding public interest according to Tier II antidegradation requirements under WAC 173-201A-320.
