To Whom It May Concern:

SoundEarth Strategies, Inc. (SoundEarth), on behalf of Alaska Boat Company, is requesting an extension of the Engineering Report and implementation deadlines for the Level 3 Corrective Action Treatment BMP for the Alaska Boat Company facility, located at 303 NE Northlake Way, Seattle Washington (the Facility). During the 2019 calendar year, the Facility had three quarterly exceedances for copper triggering a Level 3 Corrective Action Treatment BMP. The Facility retained SoundEarth to provide Level 3 Corrective Action support in May 2020; however, due to COVID-19-related impacts, including delays to coordinate with third parties (e.g., the Seattle Department of Transportation), an Engineering Report submittal by May 15, 2020, is not feasible at this time, and we are requesting the Engineering Report submittal due date be extended to August 15, 2020. Due to the ongoing effects of COVID-19, the Engineering Report delay, and anticipated time frames to coordinate with third parties and procure required permits, we are also requesting the Level 3 Corrective Action implementation due date of September 30, 2020, be extended to March 15, 2021.

The project implementation timeline remains to be as soon as practicable, but due to the following items impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic discussed below, meeting the associated deadlines is not be feasible:

- The time required to conduct a feasibility study and evaluation of treatment options, including bench scale and pilot system studies.
- The preparation and submittal of an engineering report and approval process.
- The design of a construction bid plan set and bidding process.
- Permitting and coordination for in-water and near-water work and potential electrical work required for the treatment system through applicable city and county authorities.
- The construction of treatment system components and equipment availability.
- Contractor availability and scheduling upon receipt of the Engineering Report approval.

- Necessary coordination with neighboring properties and the Seattle Department of Transportation to develop controls for diverting run-on sheet flow stormwater currently affecting the Facility water quality.

The extension request has been submitted to maintain compliance with Section 8.D of the National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System Industrial Stormwater General Permit (the Permit). In accordance with Section 2 of the Permit, the Facility has completed the Modification of Permit Coverage Form (Attachment 1) and is in the process of submitting public notices (Attachment 2). The detailed information provided herein is intended to provide the technical basis for a time extension of a Level 3 Corrective Action Treatment BMP. If further information is needed to evaluate this extension request, SoundEarth and Alaska Boat Company are available to assist the Washington State Department of Ecology upon request.

III. Public Notice
