RE: **City of Wenatchee Acute Toxicity Testing Reduction Request**

Dear Ms. Shaw,

The City of Wenatchee has completed quarterly Acute Toxicity Testing since 2015 as required in Final Wastewater Effluent Limit listed at Special Condition S9 in **NPDES Permit WA0023949**.

The testing has consistently shown no statistically significant difference in survival between the control and the acute critical effluent concentration.

Ecology will continue to require annual acute toxicity testing through the period in which the permit has been administratively extended. Ecology will re-evaluate testing frequencies at the time of permit reissuance.
