Permit coverage will not be granted sooner than **31 days** after the date of the second public notice. **Note: The application must be submitted to Ecology on or before the date of the first public notice.** The applicant also must mail or deliver the public notice to all potentially affected waterfront residents within one week of publishing the first newspaper notice.


