Dear M. S. Johnson:

Under Chapter 90.48 RCW Water Pollution Control Laws, the enclosed State Waste Discharge Permit No. ST0007374 is being reissued to Puget Sound Naval Shipyard and Intermediate Maintenance Facility (PSNS&IMF) located at 1400 Farragut Avenue, Bremerton, WA. This permit satisfies the requirements of state laws.

The permit authorizes the Permittee to discharge treated wastewater to the City of Bremerton Wastewater Treatment Plant subject to the terms and conditions of the permit.

The Department of Ecology, in response to the passage of Initiative 97 in 1988, has adopted a regulation to recover costs associated with issuing and administering wastewater discharge permits (Chapter 173-224 WAC). The annual fee for both industrial and municipal/domestic discharges is computed according to the permit fee schedules contained in WAC 173-224-040. Ecology will notify permit holders of fee charges by mailed billing statements. Failure to pay the applicable permit fee may result in the suspension or revocation of the permit, and could result in the issuance of civil penalties or actions to enjoin the activity under the permit.

You have the right to appeal this permit within thirty (30) days upon receipt of this document. Complete details about appealing the permit are in Appendix B of the permit fact sheet. Pursuant to chapter 43.21B RCW, your appeal must be filed with the Pollution Control Hearings Board, and served on the Department of Ecology, within thirty (30) days of the date of your receipt of this document.
