RE: It Is Time to Reapply for Your Boatyard General Permit

Dear Mr. Scott Anderson:

This is a reminder from the Washington State Department of Ecology (Ecology) that your Boatyard General Permit (BYGP) requires you to reapply for permit coverage at least 180 days prior to the expiration date of the current permit (General Condition G15). **You must reapply for the BYGP by February 1, 2021.**

If you fail to reapply, your current permit coverage will terminate on July 31, 2021. If your coverage is terminated and you discharge pollutants to waters of the State, you will be in violation of the federal Clean Water Act and Chapter 90.48 RCW.

To Reapply Online

Ecology uses SecureAccess Washington (SAW) to maintain security of your data. **Please see the enclosed reapplication instructions.** You can use your existing SAW account to reapply. If you do not have a SAW account, you can create one by going to <https://secureaccess.wa.gov/>. For instructions on setting up a SAW account, visit <https://ecology.wa.gov/wqwebportalhelp>.

To determine whether a renewal application was already submitted for your permit, visit <https://fortress.wa.gov/ecy/paris/permitsearch.aspx> and search by entering the project name. Scroll down and a draft application should appear along with your current active coverage in "Documents."

Changes to Your Permit Coverage

Changes to the Permittee or Legal Responsible Party may **not** be made in this renewal process. If you need to alter the Permittee or Legal Responsible Party for permit coverage, please submit a Request for Permittee Name Change form (<https://fortress.wa.gov/ecy/publications/documents/ecy070555.pdf>) or a transfer of coverage form (<https://fortress.wa.gov/ecy/publications/documents/ecy070553.pdf>).


