

Poe Construction at 1519 West Valley Highway N., Suite 103, Auburn, WA 98001 is seeking coverage under the Washington State Department of Ecology's Construction Stormwater NPDES and State Waste Discharge General Permit. The proposed Lakewood 90 project is located at 7402 – 150th Street S.W. in Lakewood, Pierce County, Washington. The project will disturb 4.28 acres for construction of an office/warehouse use building along with the associated grading activities, paved parking and truck maneuvering areas, stormwater facility, water and sanitary sewer extensions, landscaping and franchise utility extensions. Construction stormwater will be routed through v-ditches and rock check dams to a temporary sediment pond on the site for water quality treatment prior to infiltration. Any persons desiring to present their views to the department of Ecology regarding this application may do so in writing within 30 days of the last date of publication of this notice. Comments shall be submitted to the department of Ecology. Any person interested in the department's action on this application may notify the department of their interest within thirty days of the last date of publication of this notice. Ecology reviews public comments and considers whether discharges from this project would cause a measurable change in receiving water quality, and, if so, whether the project is necessary and in the overriding public interest according to Tier II antidegradation requirements under WAC 173-201A-320.
