RE: Revocation of Your Construction Stormwater General Permit WAR125393

Dear Noordin Sayani:

On November 18, 2020, the Washington State Department of Ecology (Ecology) reissued the Construction Stormwater General Permit (CSWGP).

Our records show that you did not reapply for permit renewal under the reissued CSWGP (your Notice of Intent (NOI) for General Permit Renewal was due by July 4, 2020). Ecology sent three previous letters reminding you to reapply for permit coverage.

Revocation of Coverage

Because you did not reapply for the reissued CSWGP, Ecology has revoked your permit coverage effective January 1, 2021. This permit revocation in no way relieves you from obligations associated with any prior enforcement actions or permit fees.

Discharging stormwater from construction activity without permit coverage is a violation of the Federal Clean Water Act and Chapter 90.48 Revised Code of Washington (RCW)— the State of Washington Pollution Control Act. Failure to maintain necessary permit coverage after January 1, 2021, may result in a penalty of up to \$10,000 per day for each violation of discharging construction stormwater without a permit. If you have an active construction site, or a site where construction activity occurred but has not yet been fully stabilized, sold and/or transferred, you need to submit a new NOI immediately.

To Apply for a New Permit Online

To apply for permit coverage, go to the construction stormwater webpage at www.ecology.wa.gov/constructionstormwaterpermit and fill out the online NOI through the WQWebPortal using your SAW account.

If you do not have a SAW account, you can create one by going to <https://secureaccess.wa.gov/>.

You can find detailed instructions on how to get an account and how to apply for permit coverage at <https://ecology.wa.gov/wqwebportalhelp>.

Appeal of Permit Coverage

You have a right to appeal this revocation of coverage under the general permit to the Pollution Control Hearing Board (PCHB). Appeals must be filed within 30 days of the date of receipt of this letter. The appeal process is governed by chapter 43.21B RCW and chapter 371-08 WAC. "Date of receipt" is defined in RCW 43.21B.001(2).

To appeal this decision, you must do the following within 30 days of the date of receipt of this notice:

- File your appeal and a copy of this notice with the PCHB (address below). Filing means actual receipt by the PCHB during regular business hours.
- Serve a copy of your appeal and this notice to Ecology in paper form – by mail. Email is not accepted.
