

NOTICE: ANNOUNCEMENT OF AVAILABILITY OF APPLICATION

The City of Spokane and Spokane County Regional Water Reclamation Facility (SCRWRF) have applied for renewal of National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit coverage in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 90.48 Revised Code of Washington (RCW), Chapter 173-220 Washington Administrative Code (WAC), and the Federal Clean Water Act.

The City of Spokane owns and operates the Riverside Park Water Reclamation Facility which discharges treated wastewater to the Spokane River and is designed to handle an average monthly design flow of 79.8 million gallons per day (mgd) and a maximum design flow of 129.5 mgd (November through April) and an average monthly design flow of 59.6 mgd and a maximum daily design flow of 103.9 mgd (May through October).

FACILITY: Spokane County Regional Water Reclamation Facility (SCRWRF)

SCRWRF owns and operates a municipal wastewater treatment facility that provides advanced treatment and discharges treated, disinfected and dechlorinated effluent wastewater to the Spokane River with a monthly average design flow of 18.5 mgd.

The wastewater, following treatment, must meet the requirements of the Washington State Water Pollution Control Act and applicable regulations for a permit to be issued.

The Department of Ecology is proposing to review the applications and renew the permits and is hereby issuing public notice of its intent. Interested persons are invited to submit their name, address, and initial comments regarding the permits to Ecology at :
