Dear Mayor Larson:

Under Chapter 90.48 RCW, The Clean Water Act, and Chapter 90.46 RCW, the enclosed NPDES Permit is being issued to the City of Snoqualmie Water Reclamation Facility located at 38190 SE Stearns Road, Snoqualmie, WA. The permit authorizes the Permittee to discharge treated domestic wastewater to the Snoqualmie River according to the terms and conditions of the permit. The permit also authorizes the production, distribution, and use of Class A Reclaimed Water as allowed by Chapter 173-219 WAC and the terms and conditions of the permit.

The Department of Ecology, in response to the passage of Initiative 97 in 1988, has adopted a regulation to recover costs associated with issuing and administering wastewater discharge permits (Chapter 173-224 WAC). The annual fee for both industrial and municipal/domestic discharges is computed according to the permit fee schedules contained in WAC 173-224-040. Ecology will notify permit holders of fee charges by mailed billing statements.

You have the right to appeal this permit within thirty (30) days upon receipt of this document. Complete details about appealing the permit are in Appendix B of the permit fact sheet. Pursuant to chapter 43.21B RCW, your appeal must be filed with the Pollution Control Hearings Board, and served on the Department of Ecology, within thirty (30) days of the date of your receipt of this document.

If you choose to appeal this action or decision, you must comply with the requirements of WAC 371-08-340.
