RE: It is time to reapply for your CAFO General Permit - WAG994349

Dear Jeff Snyder:

Your Concentrated Animal Feeding Operation (CAFO) General Permit requires you to reapply for permit coverage at least 180 days prior to the expiration date of the current Permit (General Condition G17). You must reapply for the CAFO General Permit by **September 4, 2021**.

If you fail to reapply for the CAFO General Permit, your current permit coverage will expire on March 2, 2022. If your permit expires and you discharge pollutants to waters of the State, you are in violation of the federal Clean Water Act and/or Chapter 90.48 RCW.

OPTIONS TO REAPPLY

Reapply/Renew Online

The Washington State Department of Ecology (Ecology) uses SecureAccess Washington (SAW) to maintain security of your data. To reapply for permit coverage, you can:

- Use an existing SAW account or create one by going to <https://secureaccess.wa.gov/>, or
- Go to <https://ecology.wa.gov/WQWebPortalHelp> for SAW account instructions, or
- Use the **enclosed detailed instructions** to create a SAW account or reapply online.

Reapply/Renew By Mail

You may use the enclosed application form to reapply. Your application must be postmarked by **September 4, 2021**. Mail the complete application to:
