

**NOTICE: ANNOUNCEMENT OF AVAILABILITY OF DRAFT WASTEWATER
DISCHARGE PERMIT**

APPLICANT: Chevron Environmental Management Company

Seattle, King County

The Chevron Environmental Management Company has applied for a National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 90.48 Revised Code of Washington (RCW), Chapter 173-220 Washington Administrative Code (WAC), and the Federal Clean Water Act. The wastewater, following treatment, must meet the requirements of the Washington State Water Pollution Control Act and applicable regulations for a permit to be issued. Following evaluation of the application and other available information, a draft permit has been developed which would authorize the discharge of treated groundwater to Lake Union via the City of Seattle storm sewer line.

A tentative determination has been made on the effluent limitations and special permit conditions that will prevent and control pollution. Ecology will make a final determination after evaluating all timely comments received in response to this notice.
