Dear Tom Daley:

Your facility has coverage under the Washington State Department of Ecology's (Ecology) Industrial Stormwater General Permit (ISGP). Section S9.C.1 of the ISGP states that permittees shall submit a complete and accurate Annual Report to the Department of Ecology no later than May 15th of each year using Ecology's Water Quality Permitting Portal - Permit Submittal application.

According to our records, you have not submitted your 2020 Annual Report, which was due May 15, 2021, and this is a violation of your ISGP. To resolve this permit violation, you must submit your 2020 Annual Report through Ecology's Water Quality Permitting Portal (WQWebPortal) – Permit Submittal application, within 30 days of receiving this letter.
