Dear Mr. Anuszewski,

I am writing to inform you that Applied Plant Science chooses to withdraw from the wastewater permit process based on the fact that no wastewater that has been in contact with fertilizer constituents will be placed into the city sewer system and the total flow of water from water filtration is less than 25,000 gallons per day. In addition:

- No process or wash waters are/will be sent to the sewer.
- Only sanitary waste and water will be discharged to the city sewer.
- The total (non-sanitary waste) flow will be under 13,000 gallons per day
- This includes water filtration flushes and reverse osmosis water purification reject water. These are derived from city water and have not come into contact with fertilizer components.
- The discharge metered at a rate under the instantaneous limit set by City of Woodland.

Please let me know if you require any additional information for our permit application to be removed.
