Each year, the Washington State Department of Ecology (Ecology) reviews annual compliance history for the state's approximately 300 wastewater treatment plants. We recognize the plants that achieve full compliance for the year by awarding them the "Outstanding Performance Award."

We select the top performing treatment plants by reviewing each plant's compliance with its effluent limits, monitoring and reporting requirements, spill prevention planning, pretreatment, and overall operational demands of their permit. We are recognizing 125 wastewater treatment plants that were in full compliance with their permit in 2019.

Wastewater plants in your district that earned this award include:

- Upper Kittitas County Regional Wastewater Treatment Facility - 12th consecutive year
- Ellensburg Wastewater Treatment Plant - 6th consecutive year
- Snoqualmie Pass Utility District Wastewater Treatment Plant - 4th consecutive year

- Moses Lake Larson Wastewater Treatment Plant
- Quincy Water Reclamation Facility
- Vantage Wastewater Treatment Plant
