Enclosed is a draft copy of Kaiser Aluminum Washington's National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System permit and fact sheet. Please review these documents and submit comments before the end of the upcoming public comment period.

Ecology will place a public notice in the local newspaper (Spokesman Review). There will be a 45-day comment period from the date of publication. At that time, you will have the opportunity to submit comments on requirements and conditions in the permit. Ecology will review and respond to comments received during the 45-day public review period and will issue the final permit after addressing all comments. The comment period will run from December 29, 2021 to February 12, 2022.

Please do not share or forward the permit or fact sheet outside of the Spokane Tribe, the public will have the opportunity to review and submit comments on the draft documents during the upcoming public review period. The EPA has also received copies of the permit and fact sheet if you would like to contact them with questions about the documents. We are also available to meet with you to discuss this permit, if that is of interest.
