The proposed permit modification includes changing the facility name from Enwave Seattle to CenTrio Energy Seattle LLC, and discharge outfall location. Moving the outfall to the new location will negate the facility's existing mixing zone. A final determination will not be made until all timely comments received in response to this notice have been evaluated.
