The Department of Ecology (Ecology) has issued this amended Administrative Order (Order) Docket #20915 to amend Order Docket #20863 dated November 17, 2021, issued to Miles Resources, LLC as a follow up to Notice of Violation Docket #16952.

This Order describes the corrective actions required at the location known as Miles Resources, LLC, Lakeview, 2800 104th Street Court South, Tacoma, WA 98499.

#### **ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER AMENDMENTS**

On November 17, 2021, Ecology issued Administrative Order Docket #20863 to Miles Resources, LLC as a follow up to Notice of Violation Docket #16952. The Order contained requirements to correct violations of the Sand and Gravel General Permit identified during an October 7, 2021, Ecology inspection. Those requirements were:

- Immediately implement source control Best Management Practices (BMPs) as required by Permit Special Condition S8 for concrete recycling equipment, concrete stockpiles, and concrete crushing by-products.
- No later than December 31, 2021, maintain grading around the concrete recycling equipment, concrete stockpiles, and concrete crushing by-products to ensure water flows to one common drainage area.

- No later than December 31, 2021, treat all stormwater that contacts concrete recycling equipment, concrete stockpiles, and concrete crushing by-products in a lined impoundment. The lined impoundment must be designed to contain the ten (10)-year/twenty-four (24)-hour storm event as required by Permit Special Condition S3.E.3. Discharge of treated water from the impoundment, and all other discharges to groundwater are subject to the effluent limitations in Permit Special Condition S2 and must not cause a violation of Water Quality Standards.
- No later than December 31, 2021, all channels leading from the concrete recycling equipment, concrete stockpiles, and concrete crushing by-products to the lined treatment impoundment must also be lined to prevent untreated discharges to groundwater.

Ecology again inspected the Lakeview facility on December 8, 2021, to evaluate compliance with the Order. Substantial progress had been made but due to uncertainty regarding weather conditions allowing more time to complete the requirements was discussed. On December 8, 2021, Ecology received an email from Miles Resources, LLC requesting the December 31, 2021, deadlines be extended to March 30, 2022.

**The extension request is approved through this Order Amendment. All December 31, 2021, deadlines in Administrative Order Docket #20863 will now be March 30, 2022.**

No other condition or requirement of Order Docket #20863 is hereby affected by this amendment.

#### **ELIGIBILITY FOR PAPERWORK VIOLATION WAIVER AND OPPORTUNITY TO CORRECT**

Under Revised Code of Washington (RCW) 34.05.110, small businesses are eligible for a waiver of a first-time paperwork violation and an opportunity to correct other violations. We have made no determination as to whether you meet the definition of a “small business” under this section. However, we have determined that the requirements of RCW 34.05.110 do not apply to the violation(s) due to a conflict with federal law or program requirements, including federal requirements that are a prescribed condition to the allocation of federal funds to the state.

#### **FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH THIS ORDER**

Failure to comply with this Order may result in the issuance of civil penalties or other actions, whether administrative or judicial, to enforce the terms of this Order.

#### **YOUR RIGHT TO APPEAL**

You have a right to appeal this Order to the Pollution Control Hearing Board (PCHB) within thirty (30) days of the date of receipt of this Order. The appeal process is governed by Chapter

43.21B RCW and Chapter 371-08 Washington Administrative Code (WAC). "Date of receipt" is defined in RCW 43.21B.001(2).

To appeal you must do both of the following within thirty (30) days of the date of receipt of this Order:

- File your appeal and a copy of this Order with the PCHB (see addresses below). Filing means actual receipt by the PCHB during regular business hours.
- Serve a copy of your appeal and this Order on Ecology in paper form - by mail or in person. (See addresses below.) E-mail is not accepted.

You must also comply with other applicable requirements in Chapter 43.21B RCW and Chapter 371-08 WAC.

Your appeal alone will not stay the effectiveness of this Order. Stay requests must be submitted in accordance with RCW 43.21B.320.
