The Department of Ecology (Ecology) has issued this amended Administrative Order (Order) Docket #20980 to amend Amended Order 1 Docket # 20192 dated July 20, 2021, and Order Docket #19524 dated December 15, 2020, issued to the Cowlitz County Public Works Department.

This Order describes the corrective actions required at the location known as Headquarters Landfill located at 3434 South Silver Lake Road, Castle Rock, Washington.

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER AMENDMENTS

Order 19524 required:

If the Headquarters Landfill exceeds the permitted average monthly or maximum daily effluent five-day Biochemical Oxygen Demand (BOD₅) limit three (3) times during the next year, within sixty (60) days of the third (3rd) exceedance, submit an Engineering Report, that meets the requirements of Washington Administrative Code (WAC) 173-240 to Ecology for review, amendment, and approval. The Engineering Report will describe a leachate treatment system that will treat the discharge to comply with the effluent limits, and a schedule to complete its installation and to begin treating the discharge.

The condition was amended on July 20, 2021, as follows:

- The Engineering Report is due December 31, 2021, to be able to fully evaluate the applicable technologies.
- Due to uncertainties associated with the testing logistics, and analytical results, the County will set up a meeting with Ecology in quarter four (4) of 2021 (October-November) to discuss the progress, and visit the report deadline in relation to results of the tested technologies.

The condition is further amended as follows:

- The Engineering Report is due January 31, 2023, to be able to fully evaluate the applicable technologies.

No other condition or requirement of Amended Order 1 Docket # 20192, or Order Docket #19524 is hereby affected by this amendment.

ELIGIBILITY FOR PAPERWORK VIOLATION WAIVER AND OPPORTUNITY TO CORRECT

Under Revised Code of Washington (RCW) 34.05.110, small businesses are eligible for a waiver of a first-time paperwork violation and an opportunity to correct other violations. We have made no determination as to whether you meet the definition of a “small business” under this section. However, we have determined that the requirements of RCW 34.05.110 do not apply to the violation(s) due to a conflict with federal law or program requirements, including federal requirements that are a prescribed condition to the allocation of federal funds to the state.

FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH THIS ORDER

Failure to comply with this Order may result in the issuance of civil penalties or other actions, whether administrative or judicial, to enforce the terms of this Order.

YOUR RIGHT TO APPEAL

You have a right to appeal this Order to the Pollution Control Hearing Board (PCHB) within thirty (30) days of the date of receipt of this Order. The appeal process is governed by Chapter 43.21B RCW and Chapter 371-08 WAC. “Date of receipt” is defined in RCW 43.21B.001(2).

To appeal you must do both of the following within thirty (30) days of the date of receipt of this Order:

- File your appeal and a copy of this Order with the PCHB (see addresses below). Filing means actual receipt by the PCHB during regular business hours.

- Serve a copy of your appeal and this Order on Ecology in paper form - by mail or in person. (See addresses below.) E-mail is not accepted.

You must also comply with other applicable requirements in Chapter 43.21B RCW and Chapter 371-08 WAC.

Your appeal alone will not stay the effectiveness of this Order. Stay requests must be submitted in accordance with RCW 43.21B.320.
