On January 24, 2020, the Washington Department of Ecology ("DOE" or "Ecology") published notice of the availability of a draft permit, NPDES Waste Discharge Permit No. WA0022403 ("draft Permit"), and related draft Fact Sheet, for the Snoqualmie Water Reclamation Facility ("SWRF"). The notice invited written comment on the draft Permit and draft Fact Sheet, to be submitted within 30 days after publication of the notice.

Pursuant to DOE's notice, I am transmitting the City of Snoqualmie's written comments below on the draft Fact Sheet and draft Permit. These comments are submitted within thirty days of the January 24, 2020 public notice, with the thirty days calculated as provided in WAC 371-08-310 (when the last day
