Off-Specification/Spoiled Raw Materials		
Cucumbers	440,000 - 660,000	Solids are collected into plastic bins, loaded into trucks and returned and to the farm fields
Cabbage	0 - 1,000,000	Solids are collected into plastic bins, loaded into trucks and returned and to the farm fields
Peppers*	0 - 80,000	Solids are collected into plastic bins, loaded into trucks and returned and to the farm fields
Off-Specification/Spoiled Product		
Pickles	0 - 20,000	Solids would be collected into plastic bins, loaded onto trucks and returned to the farm fields
Sauerkraut	0 - 10,000	Solids would be collected into plastic bins, loaded onto trucks and returned to the farm fields
Pickled Peppers*	0 - 5,000	Solids would be collected into plastic bins, loaded onto trucks and returned to the farm fields
Solids From Settling Tank*	0 - 8,000	Pumped and taken away by a vacuum truck service. The cutting room is currently not in use, so the settling tanks are also not in use.
Material Removed From the Stormwater Oil-Water Separator	100 - 1,000	Pumped and taken away by vacuum truck service.

* Currently Solid Waste from Peppers, Pickled Peppers and Solids From Settling Tank are not being generated.
