The Washington State Department of Ecology (Ecology) received your request to transfer a portion of a permitted site covered under the Construction Stormwater General Permit (CSWGP). This is your permit coverage letter to document the transfer. Your permit coverage is effective September 2, 2022.

Retain this letter as an official record of permit coverage for your site. You may keep your records in electronic format if you can easily access them from your construction site. ### **Electronic Discharge Monitoring Reports (WQWebDMR)**

This permit requires you to submit monthly discharge monitoring reports (DMRs) for the full duration of permit coverage (from the first full month of coverage to termination). Your first sampling and reporting period will be for the month of **October 2022** and your first DMR must be submitted by **November 15, 2022**.

You must submit your DMRs electronically using Ecology's secure online system, WQWebDMR. ### **Annual Permit Fees**

RCW 90.48.465 requires Ecology to recover the costs of managing the permit program. Permit fees are invoiced annually until the permit is terminated. Termination conditions are described in the permit.
