Dear Jeanette Hopkins:

You applied for a Conditional No Exposure (CNE) Exemption on September 26, 2022.

The Washington State Department of Ecology (Ecology) has determined that your site is eligible for a CNE Exemption. Your CNE Exemption has been granted starting on the above application date.

If there is a change at the facility that results in the exposure of industrial activities or materials to stormwater, you are required to immediately apply for and obtain a permit (Industrial Stormwater General Permit, Special Condition S1.F.1.d). If you need to apply for a permit, visit [Ecology's WQWebPortal guidance webpage](https://ecology.wa.gov/Regulations-Permits/Guidance-technical-assistance/Water-quality-permits-guidance/WQWebPortal-guidance)<sup>1</sup> for application instructions.

Ecology may also conduct a site visit in the future to verify that pollutants are not exposed to stormwater at your site.

**Your Right To Appeal**

You have a right to appeal this CNE approval to the Pollution Control Hearings Board (PCHB) within 30 days of the date of receipt of this CNE approval. The appeal process is governed by Chapter 43.21B RCW and Chapter 371-08 WAC. "Date of receipt" is defined in RCW 43.21B.001(2).

To appeal you must do all of the following within 30 days of the date of receipt of this CNE approval:

- File your appeal and a copy of this CNE approval with the PCHB (see addresses below). Filing means actual receipt by the PCHB during regular business hours.
- Serve a copy of your appeal and this CNE approval on Ecology in paper form - by mail or in person. (See addresses below.) E-mail is not accepted.

You must also comply with other applicable requirements in Chapter 43.21B RCW and Chapter 371-08 WAC.
