

**NOTICE: PUBLIC NOTICE OF DRAFT PERMIT, FACT SHEET AND PUBLIC HEARING  
WATER QUALITY PERMIT REISSUANCE OF KING COUNTY'S WEST POINT  
WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT**

The Department of Ecology (Ecology) proposes to renew the National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) water quality permit for the King County West Point Wastewater Treatment Plant in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 90.48 Revised Code of Washington and the Federal Water Pollution Control Act (Clean Water Act).

Ecology is in the process of renewing the King County West Point Wastewater Treatment Plant (King County) individual water quality permit. The water quality permit establishes conditions King County must meet to legally discharge treated wastewater to Puget Sound from their West Point facility. It also contains requirements to control water pollution from combined sewer overflows (CSO) that discharge into the Duwamish River, including the Lower Duwamish Waterway, and other surface waters around Seattle. Collectively, the requirements in the final water quality permit establish the minimum standards King County must meet to protect water quality.

**PUBLIC HEARING AND PUBLIC COMMENT**

**The public comment period opened on April 5, 2023 and will close on June 5, 2023.** Ecology scheduled two virtual public hearings (via Zoom) that start with a brief informational presentation about the draft permit and the permitting process.

**The virtual hearings are scheduled for May 9, 2023 at 6:00 p.m. and May 16, 2023 at 2:00 p.m.** Details on how to attend a hearing, a link to submit and additional information can be found at <https://ecology.wa.gov/WestPoint-Renewal>

Ecology will accept written comments on the draft permit from April 5, 2023, through June 5, 2023. Ecology prefers online comment submission via the eComment form (see link below).
